**Clinical Plan for Teaching Activities**

As a part of FCS 465: Introduction to the FCS Internship, you will be required to complete a minimum of 120-150 hours of activities. In order to successfully prepare for the teaching internship, you are required to meet a list of clinical experience expectations. See following pages for the required clinical activities. You will also want to add your own ideas and implement those recommended by your cooperating teacher.

***To get started:***

1. Remember that consistency and commitment are important keys to scheduling times at your school. Your cooperating teacher and students will be looking for you and often counting on you to be there and to be involved. Having a well-thought-out plan will ensure better communication and a basis on which to be flexible.
2. With the assistance of your cooperating teacher, develop an internship plan tentative schedule and/or calendar of your intended visits and what they should accomplish. Use the attached list of activities to guide your planning process.
3. Directly on the internship plan, include a notation of the activities you hope to accomplish at each visit. The idea is that each visit should have some purpose.

Cooperating teachers will be asked to verify activities upon completion and at the end of the student teaching internship.
